As we head into June and higher summer water use, here are quick answers to the most common questions we get from customers!

Top 3 Questions We Get Asked and Their Answers:

1. **Why is my water bill higher in the summer?** Higher summer bills are usually due to increased outdoor water use. (Irrigation, watering, kids playing in sprinklers, and watering livestock.)
2. **How do I know if I have a water leak?** We recommend starting by checking your water meter when no water is being used. If the meter is still moving or shows an increase over time, you likely have a leak somewhere on your property.
3. **Why does my water pressure fluctuate in the evenings now?** During warmer months, overall water use increases. In the evenings most people are home and can lead to higher demand which can cause normal pressure fluctuations.
