Chairman Bland called for discussion on the minutes from the April 16, 2024, regular board meeting. Director Griffith motioned to approve the April 16, 2024 minutes. Director Robbins seconded the motion. All Directors present voted in favor of the motion.

Chairman Bland called for Item #8 the general manager's report. Mr. Wright delivered the general manager's report. Mr. Wright has contacted Foley concerning a generator rental program for emergencies. Discussion followed. Mr. Wright provided an update on Viking's inspections. Discussion followed. Director Griffith made a motion to hire Viking to repair the hole in the

tank and overflow on Tower #2. Director Teppe seconded the motion. All directors present voted in favor of the motion.

Mr. Wright provided an update on the half mile 8" line Standard Drilling replaced. It is completed. Discussion followed.
